

SIX EIGHTS If you pick an orange popsicle, then a lemon, then a cherry, then orange, lemon, cherry...what flavor is the 1st popsicle?

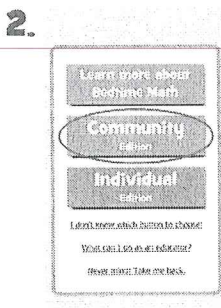

Doing Bedtime Math at home helps kids at school!

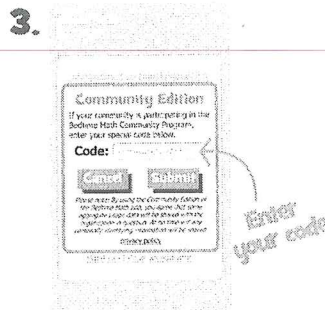
University of Chicago found kids' math skills improved by 3 months in one school year.

With a few clicks, it's easy to download!

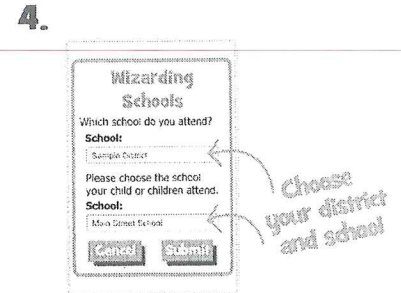
1. Download the **Bedtime Math app** for iPhone/iPad on the **App Store**, or for Android on **Google Play**.



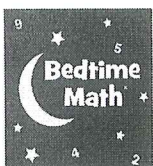
Open the app and click **Community Edition**.
